CLEANING WITH HOUSEHOLD ITEMS

Baking Soda

Great all purpose scrubber for sinks, ovens and grout --so repurpose that carton after it expires in your refrigerator or freezer

Lemon

Clean your fridge, cutting boards and even your glass coffee pot

Cornstarch

Shampoos, carpets and rugs

Vinegar

Cuts grease and cleans mildew (do not use on granite counter tops)



HOMEMADE ARTS AND CRAFTS

Soap Bubbles

6 cups of water
2 cups of Dawn dish soap
 $\frac{3}{4}$ cup corn syrup

Slowly combine all ingredients in a large bowl
Let sit for 1 hour--or more before using

Play Dough

1 cup water
1 tablespoon oil
1 packet unsweetened Kool-Aid
2 cups flour
1 cup salt

Stir together water, oil and drink mix in a medium bowl.
Stir together flour and salt in a large bowl.
Add water mixture to flour mixture and stir well.
Mix with hands until combined and smooth, 3-5 minutes.
Store in airtight container.

Sidewalk Paint

$\frac{1}{4}$ cup corn starch
 $\frac{1}{4}$ cup water
8 drops of food coloring

Mix the cornstarch and water until completely combined.
Add food coloring.
Repeat to make as many colors as you like

Recycle Old Crayons

Broken crayons
Flexible molds or muffin papers
Cookie Sheet

Pre-heat oven 250 degrees
Sort of mix colors
Place crayon pieces into molds and put on cookie sheet
Bake molds until crayons melt about 15-20 minutes
Cool completely and carefully remove from molds.
