CLEANING WITH HOUSEHOLD ITEMS

Baking Soda Great all purpose scrubber for sinks, ovens and grout --so repurpose

that carton after it expires in your refrigerator or freezer

Lemon Clean your fridge, cutting boards and even your glass coffee pot

Cornstarch Shampoos, carpets and rugs

Vinegar Cuts grease and cleans mildew (do not use on granite counter tops)



HOMEMADE ARTS AND CRAFTS

Soap Bubbles

6 cups of water Slowly combine all ingredients in a large bowl 2 cups of Dawn dish soap Let sit for 1 hour--or more before using

3/4 cup corn syrup

Play Dough

1 cup water Stir together water, oil and drink mix in a medium bowl.

1 tablespoon oil1 packet unsweetened Kool-Aid2 Stir together flour and salt in a large bowl.3 Add water mixture to flour mixture and stir well.

2 cups flour Mix with hands until combined and smooth, 3-5 minutes.

1 cup salt Store in airtight container.

Sidewalk Paint

½ cup corn starch Mix the cornstarch and water until completed combined.

½ cup water Add food coloring.

8 drops of food coloring Repeat to make as many colors as you like

Recycle Old Crayons Pre-heat oven 250 degrees

Broken crayons Sort of mix colors

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Flexible molds or muffin papers Place crayon pieces into molds and put on cookie sheet Cookie Sheet Bake molds until crayons melt about 15-20 minutes

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
